Concept Statement

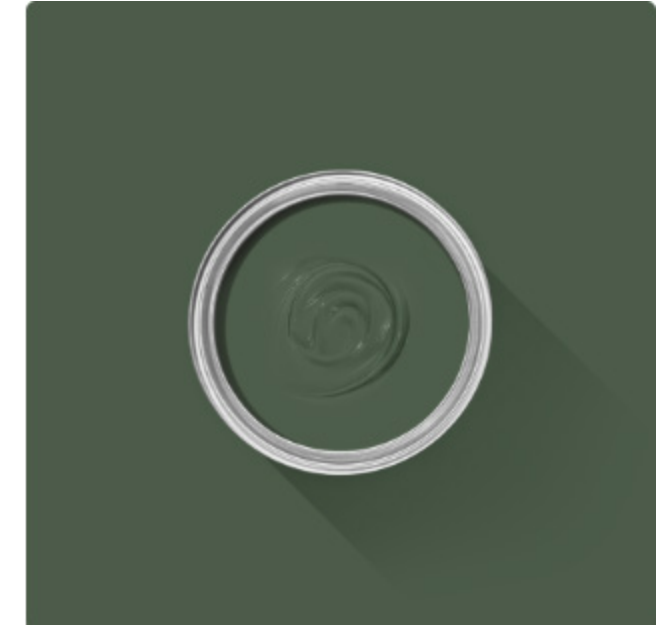
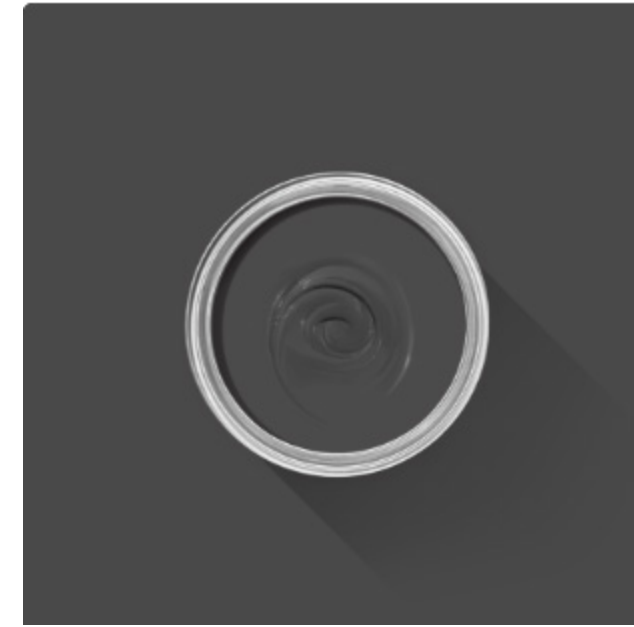
